

Crochet Bee Pattern

Start with yellow

R1: sc 7 in mr

R2: inc around

R3: sc 1, inc 1 (repeat around)

R4: sc 2, inc 1 (repeat around)

R5: sc 3, inc 1 (repeat around)

R6-10: sc around

Place eyes in between rounds 5 and 6, directly across the middle.

Switch to black

R11-13: sc around

Switch to yellow

R14-15: sc around

Switch to black

R16-18: sc around

Switch to yellow

R19-20: sc around

R21: sc 2, dec 1 (repeat around)

***Note: You may end up with an extra stitch at the end of your rounds, just carry on crocheting as usual. It won't affect your project.**

R22: sc 1, dec 1 (repeat around)

R23: dec around

***Note: Stuff the bee with your excess yarn.**

Switch to black

R24: sc around in front loops only

R25: sc around

Cinch closed

Wings

Start with white

R1: hdc 7 in mr

R2: hdc inc around

R3: hdc inc around

Slst 1 in each of the next 5 stitches, then fasten off.

For the second wing, do the 4 slst's while attaching it into the other wing. Demonstration is in the video tutorial.

Sew the wings onto the body, and you're done!
